RE: Spravato® (Esketamine Nasal Spray) Billing and Coding Update

EFFECTIVE: January 1, 2021

This informational letter (IL) updates [IL No. 2481-MC-FFS](#)¹ dated June 27, 2023

Spravato® (esketamine nasal spray) is U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-approved, in combination with an oral antidepressant, for treatment-resistant depression in adults and for the treatment of depressive symptoms in adults with major depressive disorder with acute suicidal ideation or behavior.

Spravato® is a medical benefit under the Iowa Medicaid program. Iowa Medicaid and the managed care organizations (MCOs) require that providers use Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code S0013 when submitting a claim for Spravato®. HCPCS code S0013 does require a prior authorization. Please contact FFS or the appropriate MCO for prior authorization requirements.

Spravato® must be administered under the direct supervision of a healthcare provider and requires post-administration observation under supervision. Providers should use appropriate evaluation and management (E&M) codes when billing for healthcare provider services required for Spravato® administration and post-administration observation.

- Exception: When billing a Medicare crossover claim, the Medicare codes G2082 or G2083 should be used.

- If a provider acquires Spravato® through a Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategies (REMS) certified pharmacy, the pharmacy must bill a medical claim for the drug using HCPCS code S0013 and the provider may submit a claim with E&M codes for administration and post-administration observation (if Medicare crossover claim: G2082 or G2083).

SUMMARY – Billing Options for Providers

Buy and Bill	Acquire through a REMS-certified pharmacy
▪ Bill under the medical benefit. ▪ For Medicare crossover claims ONLY: Bill using Spravato® HCPCS G2082 or G2083 for administration and post-administration observation. ▪ For all other claims: Bill using Spravato® HCPCS (S0013) and appropriate E&M codes for administration and post-administration observation.	▪ Pharmacy should bill under the medical benefit using Spravato® HCPCS (S0013). ▪ Provider does not bill for drug. ▪ Provider may bill appropriate E&M codes for administration and post-administration observation.
