APPLIES TO: Managed Care (MC) and Fee-for-Service (FFS)

FROM: Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Iowa

RE: Nursing Facility Infrastructure Funding (NFIF)

EFFECTIVE: Upon receipt

The Nursing Facility Infrastructure Funding is a source of funding for nursing facility infrastructure-related expenditures.

To qualify for Nursing Facility Infrastructure Funding, a facility must have completed one of the following major renovations:

- Undertaken a complete replacement of a facility,
- Improved infection control by replacing or enhancing an HVAC system (Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning),
- Began a new construction project, or
- Undertaken a major renovation to improve Life Safety Code requirements, or
- Developed Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) waiver services.

There are two options for reimbursement available to nursing facilities.

- 1. Capital cost per diem instant relief add-on per patient days, or
- 2. Enhancement of non-direct care component.



A provider seeking funding under the NFIF program may request both instant relief and the non-direct care component.

Requests for NFIF funds are due no later than <u>June 30, 2025</u>.

Facilities must submit a written request to the Iowa Medicaid, in care of ltssfacilities@hhs.iowa.gov with the following:

- A detailed description of the reimbursement option they intend to apply for,
- A detailed description of the project, and
- A copy of the statistical page from the facility's most recent cost report submitted.
