RE: Statewide Provider Revalidation Initiative

EFFECTIVE: Upon Receipt

Iowa Medicaid is launching a statewide provider revalidation initiative in response to requirements from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). This effort is designed to strengthen program integrity, ensure accurate provider information, and reduce fraud, waste, and abuse.

Revalidation will occur over a two-year period, from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2028. Providers will receive revalidation notices in phases. Each provider will have approximately 30 days to complete the revalidation process once notified.

This initiative will allow Iowa Medicaid to:

- Complete revalidation for all enrolled providers
- Improve the accuracy of provider enrollment data
- Reduce administrative burden by using Medicare screening results where applicable
- Support long-term improvements to program integrity
