The purpose of competency-based training, TA, and consultation is to:

- Generate positive outcomes for members.
- Generate positive outcomes for providers.
- Provide a better understanding of, and compliance with, state and federal regulations concerning service provision.
- Increase staff competencies in direct service.
- Increase access to state-wide training for direct support professionals.

Technical assistance (TA) is provided upon request for LTSS providers statewide and can include provider-specific education and support based on need. Please complete <u>TA referral</u> form⁴ to submit your current needs to our training specialist. Requests for TA may come from LTSS providers, training participants, HCBS specialists, HHS staff, or others. TA is available in person and via phone, video conferencing, or email. If you are an HCBS provider, your HCBS specialist will be informed of the requested TA and will be involved in education and/or collaboration. TA may be requested for topics including, but not limited to:

- Questions, comments, recommendations, and concerns arising from competency-based training.
- Development and implementation of strategies for quality assurance and improvement.
- Interpretation and application of rules and regulations.
- Best practices in any of the topic areas of training.
