On 06/12/25 complaints were reported regarding the center having issues with a sink not draining in the 1-year-old room and 3-year-old room. Their allegedly an odor coming from the sinks in these rooms and the cleanliness of the center is declining.

It was also reported that staff have not completed background checks.

Inspection Findings:

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On 06/17/25 I completed an unannounced visit to this center and met with both director Kelli Beedle and asst. director Abbi Gerholt. We spoke directly about the concerns reported and I was given access to all of their files and observed the center.

I observed both sinks and they are somewhat slow draining, but I did not smell any odors. This has been a problem in the past and they have addressed it appropriately with contacting a plumber who assisted and corrected this issue. It has now returned. They have contacted the plumber on 06/16/25 and are waiting for him to come to the center. I did not smell anything, and the center was clean at the time of my visit.
