Dear Child Care Provider:

This letter is in regards to the compliance visit at your Registered Child Development Home C conducted on 02/08/2018. lowa Code Chapter 237A and 441 lowa Administrative Code, Chapter 110, describes specific requirements that must be met by a Registered Child Development Home. You are not a participant in the voluntary Quality Rating and Improvement System. The following areas were out of compliance at the time of the visit:

441 IAC 110.7 Provider Requirements

441 IAC 110.8 Standards. Conditions in the home are safe, sanitary, and free of hazards.

Findings:

Per the compliance visit completed on 2/8/18, the following corrections are necessary based on the above mentioned rules:

1. The home has 2 electric fire places, the home is a split level with one fire place on the upper level and the other on the lower level. The upper level where children were present was not lit and you reported is not used while daycare children are on this level. The button to turn on the fireplace is accessible to children. The lower level fire place did not have children in this area but was on. The lower level is used only for school age children who were not present at today's visit. This fire place also has a child accessible on button. Please be sure to discontinue use of both fireplaces during daycare hours. You will also need to add a barrier to the fire place or on button to prevent children from having any access or accidentally turning the fire place on. This can be a gate or play yard to block the fire places off. You may also add a cover to the button or another barrier of your choosing.

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Corrective Action Required:

Discontinuing use of the fire place during daycare hours must be implemented immediately. A barrier must be obtained by 2/23/18. No recheck is planned at this time. Please text pictures to verify a barrier has been implemented to 515-219-0189, photographs of the corrections can be kept in your file.

Non-compliance with any of the mandated requirements listed above may lead to the cancellation or revocation of your Child Development Home Registration. Please take whatever steps are necessary to completely address each of the violations noted above. It is essential you correct all above-mentioned violations.
