II. IDENTIFY THE AREAS OBSERVED ON THE VISIT:

An unannounced licensing visit was made on 4-22-2025. Immanuel Little Lambs Preschool is located in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Greenfield, IA. Preschool services are provided to three to five year olds. Kristen Walker is the director, she has her CDA, BA degree in Elementary Education and has several reading and prekindergarten endorsements. Kristen Walker is also the director of B-F Kindergarten located in Bridgewater, IA. Kristen has many years of experience in the child care and education.

The center is overseen by a Board.

There are 42 children enrolled.

I met with Kristen Walker during my licensing visit.

Observation of rooms:

The center looked very nice, two program rooms are used. The center uses a combination of the Creative Curriculum, the Owls Literacy Curriculum, as well as their own learning curriculum developed over the years. Kristen provides a monthly calendar. Thirty children and three staff were present. The children were having fun participating in an activity and playing outside. The staff had excellent interactions with the children, they were positive and attentive to the needs of the children. The center has a fun variety of age and developmentally appropriate equipment and supplies.

The program provides activities throughout the year i.e. guys night, gals night, grand parents day, Christmas program, zoo field trip (parents drive their children) and graduation.

Kristen will be hiring a new staff person.

Nutrition:

The center provides the daily snack. Make sure you follow the CACFP food program guidelines.

Health and safety:

Monthly fire/tornado drills are practiced and documented.

The center is using Hillyard QT plus system for sanitizing toys and disinfecting the restrooms. They are using bleach/water for sanitizing the tables. Radon testing was done in February 2024 with a test result of 3.3. pCi/L the program has a radon mitigation system. Radon testing requirements have changed, please review the radon rule below.

b. Within one year of being issued an initial or renewal license, centers operating in facilities that are at ground level, use a basement area as program space, or have a basement beneath the program area shall have radon testing performed as outlined in a nationally recognized radon measurement protocol.

If testing determines confirmed radon gas levels in excess of 4.0 picocuries per liter, radon mitigation procedures shall be developed. If radon mitigation is in place, retesting shall occur at least every two years from initial measurements to confirm radon gas levels are below 4.0 picocurie per liter is in place. If initial testing confirmed radon gas levels are below 4.0 picocurie per liter, retesting shall occur at least every five years from initial measurements.

If the center has fuel burning appliances an annual fuel burning inspection is required.

Make sure you have a current fuel burning inspection/boiler inspection. The one I saw expired October 2024.

Playground:

The center has a playground area and monthly inspections were completed. Equipment is at ground level and doesn't require surfacing, there is a playhouse and a child size picnic table. The updated monthly playground safety inspection form was email to Kristen on 4-23-2024.

Transportation:

The center doesn't provide daily transportation services. In the past community agencies have come to the center for presentations to children. The center takes one field trip at the end of the year to the Blank Park Zoo in Des Moines. Parents are responsible for their child's transportation to this field trip.

Administrative records:

Three staff files were read, please make sure you maintain the required contact hours of training every year. Eight hours of approved training is required for the director and on-site supervisor.

Children's files were read and were in excellent order.

Kristen maintains excellent communication with parents and provides a monthly calendar/newsletter of events. Parent teacher conferences are held each year.

The center has a spring supper fundraiser.

III. IDENTIFY THE OBSERVED STRENGTHS OF THE CENTER:

Kristen has been teaching preschool for twenty eight years at Immanuel Little Lambs Preschool, this is an amazing accomplishment. Your program is a wonderful resource for the community. Kristen has excellent relationships with the church and the community. The center receives grants and they have an annual fundraisers to help with purchasing new equipment, furniture, outdoor toys, etc.

Kristen is confident as the director and is very enthusiastic and proud of her centers. She is organized and maintains licensing documentation in a binder. Kristen is also the director at B-F Kindergarten located in Bridgewater, IA. She has many years of experience in preschool/child care and education. Kristen has her CDA and her Elementary Education degree with reading and Pre K endorsements.

Kristen maintains excellent communication with parents and uses Facebook for additional communication with parents. Teacher conferences are held each year. A monthly calendar/newsletter of events are provided to parents.
