- Child files were in full compliance.
- The director and 3 year old preschool both have Early Childhood Degrees.
- The center has extended hours to provide quality child care for working parents.
- The center is clean and welcoming to those who enter.
- The children have access to a wide variety of education activities.
- Staff interactions with the kids were very pleasant and nurturing.

**IV. IDENTIFY THE ASPECTS OF OPERATION THAT FALL BELOW THE STANDARDS REVIEWED:**

-A staff purse was accessible to the children. It is imperative that these are stored inaccessible to children at all times.

**V. SPECIAL NOTES/RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Based upon this review, it is recommended that this center remain in Full licensing status. The center is directed to correct the items listed in Section IV. The director gave me a verbal commitment that the noted rule violations would be promptly corrected. It is important to note, all DHS licensing standards and procedures must be maintained during the renewal

period.
