CHILD CARE ANNUAL EVALUATION

1. Basic Overview

I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category B provider Melissa Scheidel on 8/13/2025. Melissa has been involved in child care for 20 years and uses the main floor only of her ranch style home. Melissa has 2 HHS-approved assistants, and 2 HHS-approved substitute/assistants on her registration. She does not use her substitutes on a regular basis. Melissa has a fenced-in back yard for outdoor play space and also uses her front porch sometimes in the afternoon to stay in the shade.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Melissa typically stays at 8 or less children in care per day, allowing for good control of her environment. She has a regular schedule of music, art, and activities for the children, with lots of time for free play mixed in. Melissa offers an open and clutter free space for children to play. They have regular time outside when weather permits.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

110.9 (3) c : Certification of two hours of approved training relating to identification and reporting of child abuse within three months of employment.

110.9 (3) d : Certification in infant and child first-aid that includes mouth-to-mouth resuscitation. If they are unable to locate first aid training that includes mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, they must complete both a first aid course and CPR.

Substitute/Assistant Nathan's Mandatory Reporter training and First Aid/CPR both recently expired and need to be renewed.

No re-check is required at Melissa's operation. The above corrections need to be in place by 10/17/2025 and will be reviewed during her next visit.
