A concern was called in regards to the condition of the home and back yard/fence.

I arrived unannounced at the Holmes residence on 2/27/26. Following a thorough inspection of the home, I found the home to be safe, sanitary and free from hazards. The backyard had some rusty tools and car parts laying around. Tamela reported they have not been in the backyard due to the continuing winter weather conditions but will get this cleaned up right away. I did notice that there is a 3-4ft high retaining wall that runs along the alley way. There is a garden fence that is being used to block the children's access to the alley, but I believe it would not support the weight of a child if they leaned on it or tried to climb it. I discussed this with Tamela, and she agreed to install a sturdier fence. She agreed to sign a safety plan whereby she would have the yard picked up and the fence installed before the children would be allowed to play in the yard.

Rule Basis and Findings of Complaint(s):

110.8 Conditions in the home shall be safe, sanitary, and free from hazards.

There is not a preponderance of evidence that the home is unsafe for children.

110.8(2). Outdoor space.

a. A safe outdoor play area is maintained in good condition throughout the year. Play area has a fence when located on a busy thoroughfare or near a hazard. Has both sunshine and shade areas. Is kept free from litter, rubbish, and flammable materials. Is free from contamination by drainage or ponding of sewage, household waste, or storm water.

There were some hazards in the backyard that Tamela agreed to take care of and signed a safety plan.

Resolution and Action Required:

Tamela agreed to sign a safety plan whereby she would have the yard picked up and the fence installed before the children would be allowed to play in the yard.

No further action is required at this time.
