1. Basic Overview

Saltlynn Nail is a CDH Category A provider, living in Des Moines. She has been a registered daycare provider since 2025. Saltlynn lives in a ranch style house but currently only uses the main floor for her child care operation. Saltlynn has discussed moving her childcare operation to the basement area. Her basement is a walkout basement.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Saltlynn Nail was able to interact with me and provide care for the daycare children. Saltlynn participates in the food program. Saltlynn uses redirection and "sitting on the couch" for discipline. I observed an infant sleeping in a bouncy seat. No child is allowed to sleep in items not designed for sleeping, including but not limited to, infant seat, car seat, swing,



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bouncy seat. A safety plan was signed. A recheck was completed on 4/22/2026. On 4/22/26 I observed the infant sleeping in a pack and play and complying with safe sleep regulations. CCR&R also had a visit with you on 4/30/2026 to review safe sleep. Saltynn said the daycare children work on sight words, do arts and crafts, play games, play with toys and go outside.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

All dogs and cats have annual examinations. Records of the exams are on file and must verify that routine immunizations are current and animal is free of endo and ecto parasites.

Form 470-5153, Pet Health Examination Veterinary Health Certificate, is on file.

Fire and tornado drills are practiced monthly and documentation kept on file for the current year and previous year.

Infants shall not be allowed to sleep on bed, sofa, air mattress, or other soft surface.

110.8 (5) b : No child is allowed to sleep in items not designed for sleeping, including but not limited to, infant seat, car seat, swing, bouncy seat.

110.9 (4) d : For infants and preschoolers: An admission physical examination, on the first day of attendance, including past health history, status of present health, allergies and restrictive conditions, and recommendations for continued care when necessary. The date of the exam is not more than 12 months before the child's first day of attendance.

110.9 (4) e : For infants and preschoolers: A statement of health signed by a physician submitted annually.

110.9 (4) g : A signed and dated immunization certificate provided by the state Department of Public Health.

110.9 (4) i : Documentation signed by the parent which names persons authorized to pick up the child, their telephone number, and relationship to the child.

110.9 (4) j : Written permission from the parent(s) for their child to attend activities away from the child development home.

110.9 (4) k : Injury report forms to document injuries requiring first aid or medical care.

4. Any corrective action plans, provisional license, and safety plans-steps to get into compliance

1. All household pets need a vet statement completed on the state required form. This needs updated yearly.

2. Fire and tornado drills need practiced monthly. Record of these drills need kept for inspection purposes.

3. I observed an infant sleeping in a bouncy seat. No child is allowed to sleep in items not designed for sleeping, including but not limited to, infant seat, car seat, swing, bouncy seat. A safety plan was signed. A recheck was completed on 4/22/2026. On 4/22/26 I observed the infant sleeping in a pack and play and complying with safe sleep regulations. CCR&R also had a visit with you on 4/30/2026 to review safe sleep.
