Dear Child Care Provider:

This letter is in regards to the follow up at your Registered Child Development Home B conducted on 05/22/2019. Iowa Code Chapter 237A and 441 Iowa Administrative Code, Chapter 110, describes specific requirements that must be met by a Registered Child Development Home. You are not a participant in the voluntary Quality Rating and Improvement System. The following areas were out of compliance at the time of the visit:

Findings:

An unannounced recheck visit was completed on 5/22/19 to verify corrections for safe sleeping of infants had been made. I was allowed access to the home and was able to view an appropriate pack and play in the living room area ready for immediate use. I did review securing the pad that comes with the pack and play to ensure it is being properly used. The padding should always be secured to the attached Velcro strips to ensure the pad lays flat and is not a hazard. If the Velcro malfunctions at any point please replace the pack and play, do not use another pad that is not made for this specific product.

Other corrective action items were not addressed as the corrective actions are not yet due. You mentioned you have a planned meeting with Child Care Resource & Referral the week of 5/27/19 to further address corrections.
