II. IDENTIFY THE AREAS OBSERVED ON THE VISIT:

Administrative Change:

The center remodeled the building next to the current center (Address: 200 5th Street). They added 30 children. The building is one large classroom, a kitchen and two restrooms. This building is approved for use effective 7/18/23.

This worker arrived at Campus for Kids Daycare on 5/25/2023. The center provides childcare for infants-preschool aged children. The center is open from 6am to 6pm. The center has 38 children enrolled. The center is located inside of two commercial buildings. The center is nonprofit. The center's fire inspection was completed on 8/23/22 and 4/27/23.

The director is Donna Sorensen. Donna has her Child Development Associate's. She started in 2015.

This worker observed all classrooms. The center's curriculum is teacher created.

Nutritional practices were checked. The center provides breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack. The kitchen was maintained in a clean/orderly fashion.

Health and safety practices were also reviewed. The center had completed their fuel burning appliance inspection and radon inspection. They had a fully stocked first aid kit.

The center does not offer field trips.

The center's policies, licensing notebook, staff files and child files were reviewed. The center also had required postings.

III. IDENTIFY THE OBSERVED STRENGTHS OF THE CENTER:

- The center has maintained the director since 2007.
- The center is on Child and Adult Care Food Program.
- The center accepts Child Care Assistance.
- The center director has an established working relationship with CCR&R, the CART Program, and the nurse consultant.
