II. IDENTIFY THE AREAS OBSERVED ON THE VISIT:

This consultant made an unannounced licensing visit to Missouri Valley Head Start on 4-10-2019. Claire White began working at the center on 4-16-2018. She had previously worked at Head Starts in Clarinda and Red Oak. The program is located in a one story building that also houses school district administrative offices and Little Reds child care. There are fifteen children enrolled in the program. The program provides preschool services during the school year from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm on Mondays and 8:30 am to 4:00 pm Tuesday through Friday.

Observation of room:

The program moved to their new room in 8-2018. The children were having fun playing in the activity centers and singing. Fun children's art work in displayed. The staff had excellent interactions with the children, they were having fun with the children and involved in programming.

Nutrition:

Breakfast, lunch and snack are provided each day (breakfast and snack on Mondays), the food is catered from Treat America/Company Kitchen. The monthly menus are posted.

Health and Safety:

Monthly fire/tornado drills are practiced and documented. Radon testing was done in July 2017 with at test score of 4.0 pCi/L. Claire will have radon testing done soon.

Playground:

The center has a fenced playground area. Monthly playground safety checks are documented.

Transportation:

The center doesn't provide daily transportation.

Administration records:

The children's emergency medical contact information was reviewed and was in excellent order. Staff files were read on a previous date and were in excellent order.

III. IDENTIFY THE OBSERVED STRENGTHS OF THE CENTER:

Claire is very confident as the on-site supervisor, she is very helpful and organized. She is very enthusiastic and proud of the program. Staff had excellent interactions with the children. The center receives excellent community support. Area Education works with some children.
