1. Basic Overview

I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category C-1 provider Stacie Wrage on 4/10/2026. Stacie has been involved in child care for 33 years. Stacie continues to use the lower level only of her split level home. She has an egress window and step system to serve as a second exit from this level. The entire level is designated for child care space. The large primary space includes a gated area for the very young children and offers many different play stations. There are also two smaller rooms designated mostly for napping. Stacie had 6 children present during the time of our visit, and cares for 8 total. Stacie has a fenced back yard space for her outside play area. She has one HHS-approved substitute. Stacie is due for a renewal of her registration effective 1/31/2027.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Stacie has significant experience in child care. She is an IQ4K Level 3 provider showing her commitment to managing a quality child care operation. Stacie considers her strengths to be consistency, her follow through, and providing quality care to the families. Her files and compliance items were organized and easily accessible. Stacie has a philosophy in her curriculum that "children learn best through play". She offers a great deal of free play mixed with age appropriate activities that include arts and crafts. Stacie has regular outside time with the children as weather allows. She participates in the Food Program to enhance the quality of her snacks and meals.
