Dear Child Care Provider:

This letter is in regards to the follow up at your Registered Child Development Home B conducted on 10/26/2017. Iowa Code Chapter 237A and 441 Iowa Administrative Code, Chapter 110, describes specific requirements that must be met by a Registered Child Development Home. You are not a participant in the voluntary Quality Rating and Improvement System. The following areas were out of compliance at the time of the visit:

Findings:

Lisa Hilsenbeck, Child Care Compliance Auditor, completed a follow up visit on 10/26/17 checking the following regulations:

441 IAC 110.8(3)"b" April will place a bottle of water with her first aid supplies. Viewed first aid kit. A bottle of water has been added.

441 IAC 110.8(4) "b" April will show detailed procedures for the following emergency specific situations in her Emergency Preparedness

Plan:

Injury/Medical for Provider Injury/Medical for Child Missing/Lost Child Utility Outage

Viewed Emergency Preparedness Plan. Procedures for Injury/Medical for Provider, Utility Outage have been added. Injury/Medical for Child, Missing/Lost Child have been deselected on page 2.

441 IAC 110.9(1)"a" April needs to have the physician that examined her complete the immunization history and TB sections of her Child

Care Provider Physical Exam Report form by filling in dates and boxes in these areas. Viewed physical for April. Immunization history and TB sections have been check marked and dated.

441 IAC 110.9(1)"b" (1) April needs to show documentation of her current course completion for First Aid/CPR. Viewed current First Aid/CPR completion certificate.

441 IAC 110.9(4) Children's Files. An individual file for each child shall be maintained and updated annually or when the provider becomes aware of changes. The file shall contain:

An admission physical examination report signed by a licensed physician or designee in a clinic supervised by a licensed physician

The date of the physical examination shall not be more than 12 months before the child's first day of attendance at the child development home.

The written report shall include past health history, status of present health, allergies and restrictive conditions, and recommendations for continued care when necessary. Need physical for L.C. Viewed physical for L.C.
