The director is Stacy Brooks. Stacy has an Associated Degree in General Education and has worked at the center since 2007.

The center provides child care for 32 children.

The center is located inside of a school.

## III. IDENTIFY THE OBSERVED STRENGTHS OF THE CENTER:

- -The center classroom was nicely decorated with the children's artwork.
- -The center has a wide variety of age appropriate toys for play.
- -The center takes field trips on Monday and Wednesday during the center. They have gone to the Trampoline Park, swimming, library, Movie Theater, museums, Subway and bowling.

Records shall be maintained for current and previous year. -Fire and tornado drills have not been completed since 9/2018. It is imperative that these are done monthly as required.

Based upon this review, it is recommended that this center remain in Full licensing status. The center is directed to correct the items listed in Section IV. The director gave me a verbal commitment that the noted rule violations would be promptly corrected.
