1. Basic Overview

I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category A provider Rhonda Staker on 1/9/2026. Rhonda has been involved with child care for 8 years. Rhonda continues with a very low census operation, watching only one grandchild and some very infrequent back-up drop-ins. Rhonda is also a professional EMT in the local community. Rhonda uses the main and 2nd floor of her 2 story home. She has an open side yard for an outside play area. Rhonda has no pets or HHS-approved assistants/substitutes. Rhonda is due for her next certification renewal in 8/2027. She has no plans to expand the number of children in care at this time.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Rhonda is a professional EMT and has significant emergency/medical background experience. She keeps very low numbers, with maximum attention available to any children in care. Rhonda describes her strengths as being flexible with parents. She uses free play mixed with structured games or activities. Rhonda is a very part time provider so daily curriculum plans are not applicable with multiple children and/or ages. Rhonda offers regular outside time when she does have a child in care.
