Melissa has been a registered childcare provider since July 2007. Melissa is a category B provider and she has one assistant/substitute, her husband, Derek. Melissa's childcare hours are 7:00am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday. Melissa cares for children ages newborn to 5 years (before kindergarten). Melissa participates with the food program and she uses the Playground app.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

At the time of the compliance visit, Melissa was caring for 5 children, 3 of which were infants. The infants were sleeping and safe sleep was observed.

Melissa's childcare is located on the lower level of her home, and she has stairs to an egress window. Melissa recently put in a full kitchen in the lower level, which she says has been very useful.

Melissa says that her childcare has a "relaxed atmosphere", she likes to be flexible, and the children are considered family. Melissa says that she likes to keep things positive. Melissa provides communication about the children to their parents daily.

Melissa says that much of her program is child-lead. Melissa provides a lot of different toys and activities for the children including story time, crafts and learning of letters, numbers, colors and shapes. Melissa has outdoor activities for the children, they recently went on a nature walk with magnifying glasses. Melissa says the children like to play with sidewalk chalk and wear super hero capes.
