Rebecca was caring for 6 children at the time of the compliance visit. The children recently came inside from playing and were waiting to have lunch. Rebecca was observed assisting two children with potty training.

Rebecca says that she is flexible and has positive relationships with the families of the children she cares for. Rebecca's outdoor area has astro-turf and a large, covered gazebo so the kids don't get muddy and have plenty of shade. Rebecca also has a large front porch and says that the children enjoy playing out there as well. Rebecca says that the children enjoy homemade, health meals and limited screen time. Rebecca has workbooks for the children, she says they read books and play games. This summer Rebecca and the children planted a garden, and the kids help out watering. Rebecca has an owl box in a tree and the children get to watch the owl and see the owlets.
