I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category B provider Julie Hannemann on 5/11/2026. Julie has been involved with child care for 18 years. She continues using the middle 2 levels of her 4 story split level home. Both levels have the required 2 exits leading to the outside. The home has lots of clutter free open space. Julie had 4 children present who were playing in the driveway when I arrived. She currently cares for a total of 8 children. Julie has a partially fenced back yard and an open front yard/driveway she uses for her outside play area. She has no HHS-approved substitutes or assistants. Julie is due to renew her registration effective 12/31/2027. She has one dog in the home and has a current vet statement on file.

**2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program**

Julie's large open room in the lower middle level is all designated space for child care only. Julie describes her strengths as having a calm presence around the children and her years of experience. She likes to get the kids outside anytime weather allows, and they regularly visit the library or local community center. Julie describes her curriculum as mostly free play mixed with traditional activities. These activities include coloring, cutting, art, music and lots of reading time. Julie participates in the Food Program to enhance the nutrition of her meals and snacks.
