Filomena accepts children aged newborn to 5 years old. Filomena only accepts full-time children, and her hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00am to 5:00pm. Filomena reported that she just resigned up for the Food Program.

During the compliance visit Filomena was caring for 7 children. Filomena had two infants sitting in bouncy seats by the older children, who were playing with play-doh. Towards the end of the visit, Filomena asked the children to pick up the play-doh so they could go outside and play in the sprinkler. Filomena has a large, fenced-in yard for the children to play in. During the visit Filomena provided some positive redirection to the children and demonstrated a sense of humor.
