1. Basic Overview

Christina Johnson has been a childcare development home provider for seven years. Chris does have an assistant that is used primarily during the summer when she has higher numbers of children in care. Chris has previous certification for medication management when she worked with the aging community. This childcare development home utilizes active play to keep the children busy throughout the day. When the weather allows, they play outside and take walks in the area. The children are high energy, so outside time is imperative.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Compliance staff observed appropriate safe sleep practices during the visit, laying infants on their backs for sleep. The assistant had one infant for a while and gave that infant some tummy time before laying them down on their back for nap.

Compliance staff observed the provider utilizing redirection during the visit. She helped one child find a more quiet activity in a different area when the playing noise in the playroom got to be too much for the child.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

110.8 (3) a : All medicines and poisonous, toxic, or otherwise unsafe materials are secured from access by a child.

**While inspecting the cupboards in the kitchen and bathroom, neither are had working safety locks. This allows for children who are toilet trained to have access to cleaning supplies and poisonous materials when not in sight of the provider when on the way to and in the bathroom.
