1. Basic Overview

Michelle has been a registered child development home provider since 2007. Michelle's husband, Mark, is listed on her registration as her assistant and substitute. Michelle provides care for infants and preschool aged children but says that she would consider taking a school-age child if she's had them in care before. Michelle's childcare hours are 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

During the compliance visit, Michelle was observed interacting with the children as they talked about "red" and "green" choices. After that activity, Michelle turned on an educational/interactive video for the children which involved sensory shaker eggs. This worker was also able to observe Michelle practicing safe sleep with an infant in her care. Michelle's husband, Mark, is very handy and often makes items for the childcare, such as a climbing tunnel, a wind tunnel and Michelle stated that this winter he will be constructing a large, metal board outside so the children can play with magnets. Michelle also has the Lion's Club come to the home and provide dental and vision screening, with parental permission.
