1. Basic Overview

I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category B provider Angela Robinson on 6/12/2026. Angela has been involved with child care for 23 years. She continues using both the main and basement level of her ranch style home. Angela's primary space is her basement which is almost entirely designated for child care. She has an egress window and step system to serve as her 2nd exit from that level. Angela uses her main floor during drop-off and pick-up times. She had 6 children present during our visit, and cares for a total of 8 at this time. Angela has one HHS-approved assistant and no HHS-approved substitutes. She is using her open front yard as an outside play area. Angela is due to renew her registration effective 5/31/2027.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Angela has many years of experience in child care and had good control of her environment during our visit. She describes her strengths as good communication with the parents and maintaining a clean/organized environment for child care. Her curriculum includes lots of child led activities. Angela likes to work science learning into her activities through lots of outside time when weather allows. The children responded well to Angela during while I was there. She participates in the Food Program to enhance the nutrition of her meals and snacks.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

110.8 (1) c : Combustible materials are kept away from furnaces, stoves, gas dryers, or water heaters by a minimum of three feet.

- Angela needs to re-configure a fabric curtain that was too close to her water heater. We reviewed potential options. This needs to be completed by 7/15/2026 and will be reviewed during our next visit.

4. Any corrective action plans, provisional license, and safety plans-steps to get into compliance

The 2026 targeted compliance for the Emergency Preparedness Plan was conducted. Angela was in compliance having a plan consistent with her current operation.
