II. IDENTIFY THE AREAS OBSERVED ON THE VISIT:

This worker arrived at WEST LIBERTY CHILD CARE CENTER – 21159 on 7/1/2024 for an annual visit. The fire inspection was completed on 8/21/2023. The center is nonprofit and overseen by a board of directors. The center provides child care for infants to preschool aged children. The center is open year around. The hours of operation are 6:30am-6:00pm. Their current enrollment is 22 children.

The director is Maddie Villhauer. Maddie started in 12/2022. Maddie has a bachelor's degree in English.

The on-site supervisor is Molly Krahenbuhe. Molly started in 1/3/2023. She has a bachelor's degree in Global Health.

This worker observed all programming space in the center and outdoor area to ensure that the environment was safe, sanitary and hazard free. The center is located inside a commercial building. The center has four classrooms, a kitchen, storage space, offices and restrooms. The center's outdoor play area is being remodeled. They have climbing structures, pushing toys, riding toys, playhouses, picnic tables, sandbox, balls, etc.

Health and safety practices were also reviewed including handwashing, medication management, appropriate cleaning/sanitizing/disinfecting, excluding ill children/staff, incident reports, and first aid kits.

Nutritional practices and food safety were observed. The center is on the Child and Adult Care Food Program. The center offers breakfast, morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack.

This worker reviewed required postings. This worker checked staff files and child files. The licensing notebook including emergency drills, first aid supplies, playground checklist, radon testing, HVAC testing and policies were reviewed. The center does communicate with parents via: Brightwheel.

The center's curriculum is teacher created.

III. IDENTIFY THE OBSERVED STRENGTHS OF THE CENTER:

- The center accepts Child Care Assistance.
- Child and staff files were in full compliance on the date of my visit.
- The center now has an AED.
- The center has ensured that there are no restrictive devices in the infant room.
- The center is clean and well organized.

IV. IDENTIFY THE ASPECTS OF OPERATION THAT FALL BELOW THE STANDARDS REVIEWED:

109.10(3)c: For ongoing, long term medications, authorization shall be obtained for a period not to exceed the duration of

prescription.

-An expired epipen must be replaced with a current epipen.

V. SPECIAL NOTES/RECOMMENDATIONS:

Based upon this review, it is recommended that this center remain in Full licensing status.
