CHILD CARE ANNUAL EVALUATION

1. Basic Overview

I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category B provider Traci Wright on 3/23/2026. Traci has been involved in child care for 18 years. Traci uses both her main and lower level of the ranch style home, with the primary space being the basement. Traci has an egress window and step system to serve as her second exit from that level. Much of the basement is designated for child care space only with multiple play stations. The children were engaged in free play during our visit. Traci has 3 dogs, all with current vet statements on file. She has a fenced back yard to serve as her outside play area. Traci had 6 children in care during the time of our visit and cares for a total of 10. (Several are part time.) Traci is due for her registration renewal in 4/2027.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Traci identifies her strengths as being organized, and very up front with her parents and families regarding what to expect. She carefully screens new families trying to be sure both parties are comfortable with the environment and operation. Traci describes her curriculum as being centered around a new theme every month. Activities and learning frequently follow the monthly theme. (This month's theme was "The Shamrock Cafe") The children participate in arts, crafts, reading time, coloring and music. Traci collects and assembles a binder containing many of the children's arts/crafts and shares them with the parents. She offers regular outside time as weather allows. Traci participates in the Food Program to enhance the nutrition of her snacks and meals.
