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1. Basic Overview

Corie has been providing child care for almost 30 years. Corie originally worked in a center environment and eventually opened her own child development home setting. Corie accepts children aged 6 weeks through 8 years. Corie is available for care Mondays through Fridays for first shift families. Corie maintains a structured environment for kids in care with a regular set of routines followed daily. Corie also uses lesson plans to assist in her activities with children. Children experience circle time daily and a wide variety of large motor activities both indoors and outdoors. Corie uses beanbags, parachutes, 'snow ball' (fake snow) fights throughout the year, movement dice, and yoga to keep the kids moving their bodies even when they can't play outside.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Corie believes her greatest strength in providing child care is that she genuinely loves her job. Corie connects easily to children and wants to help them succeed. Corie reports she is big on communication with both children and parents alike and believes that when you do something, "you give 100%". Corie keeps up on her knowledge of ages and stages for child development so she can assist them in thriving in all environments. Corie is currently working on changing to a C 2 provider home with her daughter as the co provider. Corie maintains her paperwork in a very organized manner making it easy to locate needed compliance items each year. Corie is a participant in the CACFP food program for child care providers. Corie works well with collateral resources, including Child Care Resource and Referral and nurse consultants. Corie is working with CCRR currently on gaining IQ4K quality status.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

All dogs and cats have annual examinations. Records of the exams are on file and must verify that routine immunizations are current and animal is free of endo and ecto parasites.

Corie's assistant Kylee needs updated Mandatory Child Abuse Reporter training as hers expired in June 2026. Corie also needs updated Mandatory child abuse reporter training as hers expired in March 2026. Corie sent verification of both updated trainings via email, nothing further is required.
