On 3/4/2025, a complainant reported staff Isabella P yanked a 4yo child's leg upward when the 4yo child was not laying on the cot correctly. The complainant reported this caused the 4yo child to loose balance, hit face on the metal part of the cot and develop a bruise on the face.

Licensing Rules Relevant to the Complaint:

109.12(2) Center shall have written policy on discipline of children which provides for positive guidance, with direction for resolving conflict and setting of limits.

Inspection Findings:

On 3/11/2025, licensing along with an additional DHHS person conducted a visit to Fields of Fun Child Care. The following is based upon face-to-face interviews with management, review of video footage, observations while on-site and review of internal and external administrative items:

109.12(2) Center shall have written policy on discipline of children which provides for positive guidance, with direction for resolving conflict and setting of limits. Center does not use corporal punishment including spanking, shaking, or slapping. Punishment which is humiliating or frightening or causes pain or discomfort is not allowed. Mechanical restrains shall never be used. If part of a treatment plan for a child with a disability, staff shall receive training. Punishment or threat of punishment associated with illness, toilet training, or food or rest is not be used. No child is subject to verbal abuse, threats, derogatory remarks about child or child's family. RULE VIOLATED.

- Management discussed how and when they became aware of the incident as well as how they began an immediate internal investigation.

- Information gathered through review of video footage, verbal statements and administrative items indicated staff Isabella P grabbed the 4yo child's leg straight up in the air causing the 4yo child to loose balance and his the face on the cot resulting in a bruise to the face.

- Two staff are no longer employed at Fields of Fun Child Care.

Addendums:

- Addendum1: On 4/4/2025, co-director Haley Hollan contacted licensing indicating the child involved in the complaint was not a 4yo child but actually a 2yo child. Licensing acknowledged an error was made and informed her the age of child does not change the report findings but that it would be noted in their program's DHHS file. On 4/16/2025, owner and co-director Taryn Krahmer requested a correction to the age of the child be further documented in this format. As a result, an addendum to this report has noted the child involved in this incident was 2yo.

On 4/16/2025, licensing, Ms. Krahmer and Ms. Hollan also talked about the program's written discipline policies and procedures which are provided to each staff upon hire and regularly reviewed with all staff. Management discussed staff participating in many training opportunities (e.g. FLIP IT, PBIS, Passport), the program's participation in the Tanger Place Infant Early Childhood Mental Health Consultation (IECMHC) program, the program's participation with CCR&R for IQ4K and the program's collaboration with the Childcare Alliance Response Team (CART). Management additionally discussed mandatory reporter and incident reporting policies and procedures that continue to be followed.
