1. Basic Overview

Umi has been a registered Child Development Home Provider since 7/17/2023. Umi provides care for all ages of children. Umi stated she is willing to take a variety of children including special need children. Umi is able to provide care 7 days a week 24 hours a day. Her enrollment currently includes children ranging in ages between 5 years old to 10 years old. Umi does not transport children at this time but is willing to work with families if needed. Umi is open to providing for infants but does not have any at this time.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Umi did not have any children in care at the time of the compliance check. In conversation with Umi she identified one of her strengths is her ability to provide an environment in which children feel safe and comfortable. Umi identified she has good relationships with her current children in care. Umi said she is able to care for special need children with modifying the environment for the child's physical and mental health needs. Umi said she has great communication with the parents of the children she serves and communicates often regarding the needs of their children on a daily basis. The children in Umi's care get regular meals and snacks when in her care. If children have special dietary needs she said she is able to accommodate those needs.
