II. IDENTIFY THE AREAS OBSERVED ON THE VISIT:

Panther Academy is located inside of Shannon Elementary School.

An unannounced visit was completed on 3/19/19. All programming space was observed.

The center's approved fire inspection was completed on 9/13/17.

The director is Tammy Helgens. Tammy started in 2015. She has two years management experience and has also worked in the preschool/kindergarten classroom.

The center provides child care for approximately 77 children.

III. IDENTIFY THE OBSERVED STRENGTHS OF THE CENTER:

- -The center has done a great job maintaining staff. One staff started in 2008, 2010 and 2014.
- -Child files were in full compliance.
- -The center visits: Niabi Zoo, Imagination Station, John Deere Museum, Kernels Baseball Game, Riverboat Museum, Amana Theater for a play, swimming, library, movies, and bowling.
- -Staff are always actively engaged with the children.

IV. IDENTIFY THE ASPECTS OF OPERATION THAT FALL BELOW THE STANDARDS REVIEWED:

109.7(3): During their first three months of employment, all staff shall receive the following training: Minimum health and safety trainings, approved by the department in following areas.

-One employee needed Essentials Training.

109.11(3)d: Record of monthly inspections of outdoor recreation area and equipment shall be kept.

-Playground inspections were not completed in 11/18 or 12/18. These must be done monthly.

109.11(7)b: Centers at ground level that use basement area as program space, or have a basement beneath program space: Testing and plan for remedy of radon is conducted.

-Radon testing last done 2/17. This has been completed the center is awaiting results.

V. SPECIAL NOTES/RECOMMENDATIONS:

Based upon this review, it is recommended that this center remain in Full licensing status. The center is directed to correct the items listed in Section IV. The director gave me a verbal commitment that the noted rule violations would be promptly

corrected. It is important to note, all DHS licensing standards and procedures must be maintained during the renewal period.
