Kidz R Us Daycare LLC is located inside of a commercial building designed for child care.

An unannounced visit was completed on 6/6/18. All programming space was observed.

The center's approved fire inspection was completed on 3/1/18.

The director is Brenda Kelchen. Brenda has worked in childcare since 1988.

The onsite supervisors are Angie Wilson and Nicole Sunderman. Angie has her Child Development Associates. She has been with the center since 2015. Nicole Sunderman has an Associates Degree in Medical Assisting. She started at the center in 2015.

The center provides child care for approximately 47 children.

## III. IDENTIFY THE OBSERVED STRENGTHS OF THE CENTER:

Brenda opened the center in 2012. She has also opened two additional centers to meet the growing need in Anamosa and Wyoming.

Staff completed Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports and Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale.

Brenda has done a great job of maintaining core staff.

The center is clean and welcoming to those who enter.

#### IV. IDENTIFY THE ASPECTS OF OPERATION THAT FALL BELOW THE STANDARDS REVIEWED:

109.9(2)b: All files contain sufficient information and authorization to allow the center to secure emergency medical and dental services at any time child is in center's care.

The director gave me a verbal commitment that the noted rule violations would be promptly corrected.
