#### Summary of Complaint:

It was reported that the provider's 4-year-old great-grandson got a pair of scissors and cut a daycare child's hair. There is a concern regarding supervision.

## CHILD CARE COMPLIANT

**Rule Basis and Findings of Complaint(s):**

110.7(1)a. Gives careful supervision at all times.

110.8(3)a All medications and poisonous, toxic, or otherwise unsafe materials are secured from access by a child.

SW Bailey met with provider, Stephanie Carter, during an unannounced home visit on 9/23/2024. Stephanie was caring for three children at the time of the visit. SW Bailey asked Stephanie about the incident regarding a daycare child's hair getting cut off by another child, while in her supervision. Stephanie stated that on the day of the incident her granddaughter was hanging out at her house with her 4-year-old son, Stephanie's great grandson. Stephanie reports that her great grandson was not at her home as a daycare child, he was in the bedroom with his mother, Stephanie's granddaughter.

Stephanie stated that she went to use the restroom, and the daycare children were in the living room area and her family members were in a back bedroom. Stephanie said that when she looked into the bedroom, she thought her granddaughter was awake and watching t.v. with her son. Stephanie said that when she returned to the living room after using the restroom, she approximated to be around 5 minutes, a daycare child was standing in the hallway with her great grandson, who had scissors and had cut the other child's braids off. Stephanie said that the scissors had been in the bedroom with her granddaughter because she was taking out her braids. Stephanie said that she then noticed that her granddaughter was actually asleep in the bedroom, not supervising her son.

SW Bailey talked to Stephanie about her family members, who are not household members, should not be at her home during her business hours. Stephanie said that she understood and has told her granddaughter that she and her son cannot be at the home during the daycare hours. SW Bailey also discussed with Stephanie making sure that hazardous or sharp items are stored securely, where children cannot reach them. Stephanie showed SW Bailey where she usually stores the scissors, on top of the refrigerator.

**Resolution and Action Required:**

Stephanie signed a safety plan agreeing not to allow unapproved people in her home during daycare hours. Stephanie also agreed to keep sharp or dangerous items out of the reach of children and to provider careful supervision. Stephanie did show remorse for the child's hair getting cut and she did not blame the parent for removing the child from her daycare.

SW Bailey will make a referral regarding supervision issues to CCR&R and Stephanie Carter will be expected to cooperate with the safety plan and CCR&R.
