1. Basic Overview

Janine has been a registered childcare provider since February 2008. Janine is a category B provider and her childcare hours are 7:30am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday. Janine does not have any assistants or substitutes. Janine's childcare is located on the main level of her home; she has a playroom for the children just off of the kitchen. Janine participates with the food program and CCR&R.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Janine says that she has a very close relationship with all of her childcare families and they keep in touch long after the children leave her care. Janine also cares for several of her grandchildren.

Janine says that she is currently working on independence skills with the children, like putting on/taking off their shoes and coats, and potty training. Janine says that she helps the children learn to cut with scissors, kick balls, use pedal bikes and pump their legs to swing. Janine does not allow the children to use electronics while at her home and she limits t.v. to special occasions.

Janine says that the children spend a lot of time outside, they do water balloon fights, ride bikes and walk to the nearby park.

At the time of the compliance visit, Janine was caring for 5 children. The children had just finished an Easter egg hunt and were playing with a train set in the playroom. Janine was observed helping the children with the tracks and encouraging them to share and work together.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard
